# COMPETITION INFORMATION

## FREE TRAINING

The pitches are available for training on Wednesday and Thursday from 8:00 till 20:00 hrs. and on Friday till 17:00 hrs. At these hours the clubhouse is open as well.

## RULES

The competition will be played according the latest ICF rules (2009). This includes the use of the shot-clock. On each pitch are 2 visual shot-clocks.

For each game the referees and game-officials will be:

Team 1: 1 referee (by name), 1 line-judge, 1 table-official

Team 2: 1 referee (by name), 1 line-judge, 1 table-official

From organization: 1 table-official, as assistant

The organization provides the match balls: official men and women size by Conti.

## ACCREDITATION AND EQUIPMENT CONTROL

All players and referees have to be accredited. So at the 4 moments for accreditation the complete team has to be present. A picture will be made and the licenses will be checked. On Saturday morning the team leader can collect the accreditations at the competition office.

Additional payments should be done at the accreditation!

Accredited teams receive a form to be used at the equipment control. After the accreditation the complete team has to join the equipment control. Make sure the boot, paddles and helmets are correct and save! You are only allowed to use positively checked equipment.

We will check e.g.:

- Size of the boats, firm and save bumpers
- Position and size helmet and face-guard
- Sharp edges on paddle (blades)

Saturday 17th 08:00 hrs – 10:00 hrs.

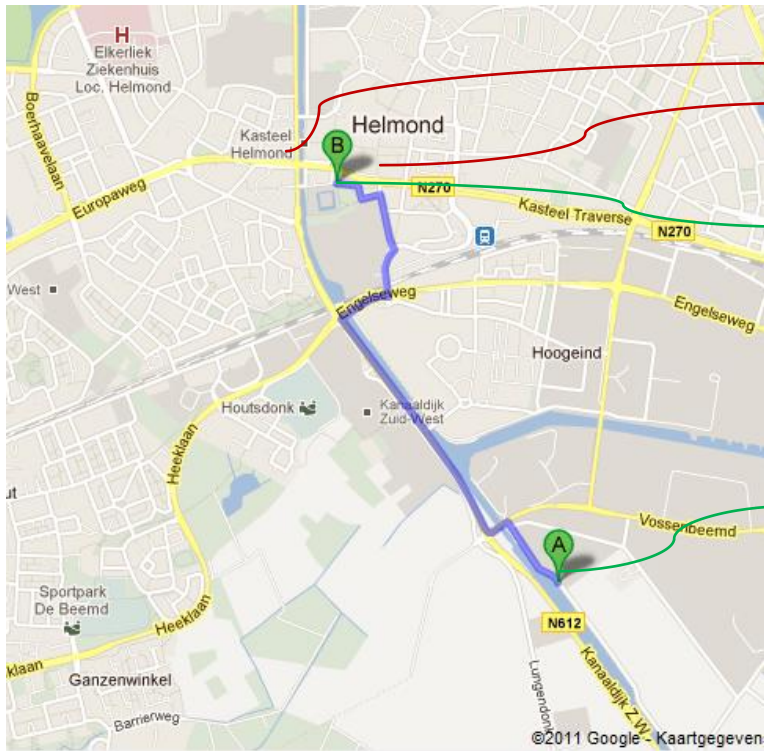
- It is the responsibility of each team to be accredited and checked in time!

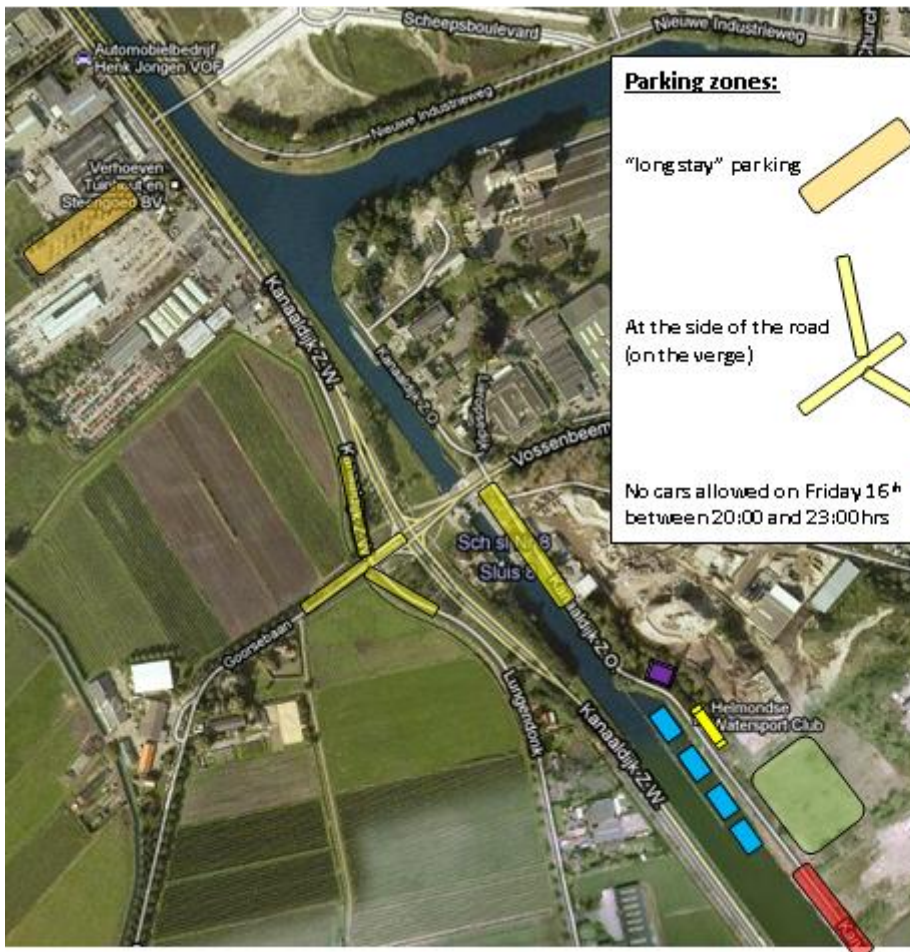

### **Parking zones:**








